Market Update and Commentary

Akambo International Equities Fund June 2025

International share markets posted strong gains in June. The S&P 500 (+4.96%) rose for a second consecutive month while the Nasdaq Composite (+6.57%) extended its rally to a third month. Despite persistent tariff concerns and heightened geopolitical tensions in the Middle East, US equities proved resilient, with both indices closing at record highs by month-end. Global markets followed, with the MSCI World and MSCI Emerging Markets indices climbing 3.8% and 5.0%, respectively. Growth-oriented sectors led the US market gains, driven by AI optimism and strong performance from Information Technology (+9.73%) and Communication Services (+7.18%), while the spike in oil prices supported the Energy sector (+4.74%). Defensive sectors lagged, including Consumer Staples (-2.12%), Real Estate (-0.49%), and Utilities (+0.08%). Investor sentiment rebounded in line with the market gains, with Bank of America's latest Global Fund Manager Survey back to pre-Liberation Day highs. The corporate earnings outlook remained robust heading into the Q2 reporting season in July, as more S&P 500 firms were issuing positive Q2 EPS quidance than average. However, risk remain with investors continuing worry about tariff impacts on inflation with annual headline inflation rising for the first time in four months to 2.4%. The Federal Reserve kept rates on hold at the June meeting noting the underlying strength of the economy and uncertain tariff impacts on prices. While most Fed officials considered a reduction in the fed funds rate likely to be appropriate at some point, they remain divided over when with a few participants suggesting a rate cut should occur as early as July while others argued for no reductions this year. Trump continued his criticism of Fed Chair Powell, suggesting rates should be much lower. Implementation of Trump's economic agenda continued with the One Big Beautiful Bill Act progressing further through the House and Senate and was on track for a symbolic July 4th Independence Day signing. The bill represents a significant shift in U.S. federal and fiscal policies, through extensive reforms in taxation, healthcare, immigration, and federal spending. The Congressional Budget Office projected the bill could add USD 3.3 trillion to the deficit over the next decade. Near-term, however, the personal income and corporate tax reforms should support growth.

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Market Update and Commentary

Monthly Performance:

The portfolio rose 2.32% in June while the benchmark MSCI All Country World Index rose 2.14% in AUD terms.

The largest contributors during June were Broadcom (AVGO) +12.09% as AI chip stocks rebounded strongly, Meta Platforms (META) +12.02%, and <u>Freeport-McMoRan</u> (FCX) +10.63% due to strong copper prices. The largest detractors were Adobe (ADBE) -8.47% despite reporting a better-than-expected Q2 result which included record revenue, CME Group (CME) -5.91%, and Mitsui & Co (8031) -4.55%.

Portfolio Changes:

During the month, we initiated a new position in EQT Corporation (EQT), the largest U.S. gas producer which should benefit from expanding U.S. natural gas demand, driven by LNG exports and power generation with rising electricity needs from AI and manufacturing.

We also initiated a new position in Uber Technologies (UBER), a global leader in ridesharing and delivery with strong earnings growth and improving profitability, as well as a new position in SalesForce (CRM), the global leader in customer relationship management software providing critical infrastructure for businesses to strengthen customer relationships, enhance marketing, boost productivity, and scale growth.

We added to positions in leading Chinese technology stocks, Tencent Holdings (700) and Alibaba Group (9988), and Adobe (ADBE) after it reported a better-than-expected Q2 result which included record revenue. We also reduced our Shell (SHEL) position, as the stock rose 8% on the oil price spike following heightened Middle East tensions.

Company Updates:

Broadcom (AVGO) reported record Q2 results in June, with EPS of \$1.58 slightly above the \$1.57 expected and record revenue of \$15B rising another 20% from Q2 last year. Free cash flow was also a record \$6.4B, up 44% year-on-year. CEO Hock Tan said "Broadcom achieved record second quarter revenue on continued momentum in AI semiconductor solutions and VMware. Q2 AI revenue grew 46% year-over-year to over \$4.4B driven by robust demand for AI networking." Adding "We expect growth in AI semiconductor revenue to accelerate to \$5.1B in Q3, delivering ten consecutive quarters of growth, as our hyperscale partners continue to invest."

Adobe (ADBE) reported better-than-expected Q2 results in June, with EPS of \$5.06 ahead of the \$4.97 expected. Record Q2 revenue of \$5.87B up 11% year-on-year was also ahead of the \$5.80B expected. CEO Shantanu Narayen said, "Our strategy to deliver ground-breaking innovation for Business Professionals and Consumers, and Creative and Marketing Professionals is delighting customers, and we are pleased to raise Adobe's FY25 revenue target." Adding "Adobe's AI innovation is transforming industries enabling individuals and enterprises to achieve unprecedented levels of creativity." FY guidance was upgraded to EPS of \$20.50-20.70 vs prior guidance of \$20.20-\$20.50.

Linde (LIN) signed a long-term Industrial Gases Supply agreement with Blue Point Number One in June. With Linde to supply industrial gases to Blue Point's 1.4 million metric tons low-carbon ammonia plant in Louisiana. Linde will build, own, and operate a world-scale air separation unit (ASU) to supply oxygen and nitrogen to the Blue Point project, expected to be one of the largest low-carbon ammonia projects in the world, investing more than \$400 million in the new on-site plant, which is expected to start up in 2029. Ammonia (NH3), traditionally used in fertilizer production, is gaining recognition as a potential energy source due to its ability to store and transport energy, particularly from renewable sources, and its potential as a carbon-free fuel.

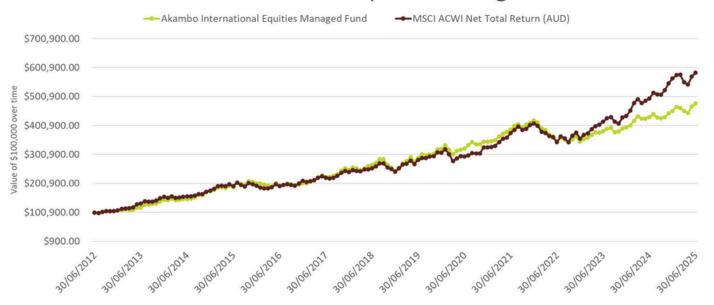
